Agnar Sandmo is professor Emeritus of Economics at the Norwegian School of Economics in Bergen. His main fields of research have been the economics of uncertainty, public economics (including the economics of the welfare state) and environmental economics. His articles in these fields have appeared in leading international journals, and his book *The Public Economics of the Environment* was published by Oxford University Press in 2000. Recently, he has been active in the field of the history of economic thought, and his book *Economics Evolving* appeared on Princeton University Press in 2011. He is a member of the Academia Europaea since 1988 and the National Academy of Sciences (USA) since 2009. He holds honorary doctorates from the University of Oslo and the University of Uppsala.
